

Mini-Tennis and Junior Membership 2010/11

Mini tennis membership is available for children from 8-10 years old playing at mini-tennis orange or green level.

Junior membership is available for children from 8-18 years old playing at junior level.

Please note that the joining fee is waived for 2010. Members may join at any time during the year.

Club Membership Advantages:

- **COACHING courses:** priority booking for term time group coaching (week days, 4.15-6.30pm) and holiday camps at all levels are available for members
- **2 Free, coach-led Club Play sessions, sponsored by the Club:**
Fridays 4.00-5.15pm, from 30th March till 15th October, term time
Saturdays 9.00-10.30am from 24th April till 4th July, term time (*this is a new initiative, if successful, could be extended*)
No need to book, just turn up and play. All supervised sessions.
Please also note that we have mini tennis red and adult improver drop-in coaching at the same time on Saturday, so you can drop the kids and play yourself!

- **ONLINE COURT BOOKING:** facility to book court 6&7 on Sunday and 7 every day ONLINE from any computer: simply key in your allotted password, make the booking, "sign in" on arrival at the Club, and the court is yours. This is a terrific new initiative to help you plan your tournament matches and to organise friendly games. No more hanging around without a court or "not sure if I'll get one".
- **Entry to "ROAD to WIMBLEDON" tournament:** if you are under 15 and have a current tennis LTA rating please contact your coach for details.
- **WIMBLEDON TICKETS:** as long as you are a Mini tennis/Junior Member aged 9 or over, and a *British Tennis* Member (you can sign up for free as an Old College member) then you can enter the Draw with an adult (or aged over 16).
- **ACADEMY:** intensive coaching. Please contact Jon Modica.
- **JUNIOR LEADERS' coaching course:** some sponsorship available for those aged 14 to 17
- **JUNIORS played up to ADULT ADVANCED level by Jon Modica can:**
 - play in the adult club sessions
 - enter the singles ladder – see (www.ropeyladder.com)
 - enter adult one day events
 - enter the Club adult Tournaments
 - make bookings on any court
