- **Free Club Play sessions:** Friday afternoon club sessions for orange and green level mini tennis members from 4:15- 5.30pm with coach supervision. Summer term and first half Autumn term. **Sponsored by the Club.**
- **Free entry to Open Club Tournament:** open to mini tennis and junior members only. This involves having your name entered in a knockout or round robin draw to play against other members. The draw runs from the end of April until September. **Finals** will be played on **Finals Day, XXXXXXXXXXXX 2010.
