## WIMBLEDON DRAW 2010

Tickets are issued in pairs to tennis Club members who have arranged payment of their current annual subscription by 30 April 2010. In order to be entered in the draw you must be a current member of the tennis section and be a member of British Tennis. The Club is also imposing the restriction that the person accompanying the applicant to the Championships should also be a Club Member in order to maximise the benefits of club membership. Those who wish to make a single application for tickets can do so.

I wish to enter the Wimbledon Ticket Draw. If successful I agree to purchase my allotted pair/single ticket and abide by the conditions of sale. Please note the following:

- Tickets are restricted to one ticket per member.
- Juniors aged 9-16 winning a ticket in the ballot, must be accompanied by an Adult over 18 who may or may not be a member of Old College. (The form needs to be countersigned by an Adult who agrees to pay the amount owing).
- These tickets are for personal use only and must not be offered for sale to anyone outside the club or publicised in any form of media or on the internet. Such advertising will render the ticket **void**
- If for any reason, the applicant cannot use the ticket, it **MUST BE OFFERED BACK TO A CLUB MEMBER**, at face value, with an e-mail to the [oclt.membership@googlemail.com](mailto:oclt.membership@googlemail.com) explaining to whom it has been transferred and the reason necessitating this.

The Applicant has the responsibility to pay in full for both tickets when collecting them and to signing a disclaimer. If the Applicant fails to collect the tickets in reasonable time as arranged with the LTA Representative, the tickets will be offered to the first people in the waiting list. The Club would prefer it if the applicant retained possession of BOTH tickets until the visit to Wimbledon.
